Dear All,

Next Friday (17<sup>th</sup> May) is a non-school uniform day. 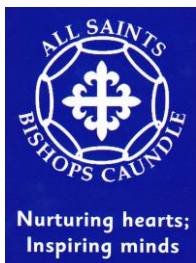
