Dear All,

In July, all pupils will receive a written report. In the report, you will be able to compare your child's prior attainment compared with where they are now and also see if they have made progress (despite an extremely disrupted 14 months or so of school). Prior to the reports, all children will complete formal assessment in maths, reading and English grammar, punctuation and spelling (EGPS). The assessment of writing is carried out each time the children write a new independent piece of work.

There will be no Parent's Evening (apart from parents of SEN pupils). However, I cannot stress strongly enough that if you have any concerns or worries about your child's education - at any time in the school year- all you have to do is contact the school office and we will arrange a meeting at the earliest possible opportunity. Please, please, please do not sit at home worrying.
