Congratulations to our Sapphire Class Netball team who played brilliantly in coming 11<sup>th</sup> out of 20 teams in the Dorset County Netball Finals. This is the elite from all the schools in Dorset, Bournemouth, Christchurch and Poole. Many of these schools have more children in Year 6 then we do in the whole school!

Diamond and Topaz Classes had a fantastic trip to Moors Valley last Friday. The children came back hot, tired but had a thoroughly enjoyable time. Many thanks to the Governors and parents who – by volunteering to help – made the trip possible.

We have a lovely local supplier who produces healthy and high-quality food: unfortunately, they have just been hit by big increases in rental prices and are having to pass on some of these charges to us. Whilst we are soaking up most of these costs, sadly, we have had to pass some on to parents / guardians.

If you have any spare colourful, evergreen plants or shrubs (ones we could keep in a planter) which you would be willing to donate to the school for our new Memory and Reflection Garden, we would warmly welcome them.

Finally, best of luck to our Year 6 pupils who have their SATs next week. They have been working extremely hard and we – as staff and governors – are so proud of them. They will have an enjoyable week, with Breakfast Club every morning and bacon sandwiches after tests every day followed by games and relaxing: we are hoping that they will have a swim on Friday too! Invariably, SATs week at All Saints becomes one of the highlights of their time here. SATs are more about the school being tested rather that the pupils, all we ask from the children that they try their best (we can ask no more than this): we have no doubt they will do this.
