Dear All,

Our Year 6 pupils had a brilliant three days at Studland earlier this week taking part in many activities including coasteering, paddle boarding and raft building. I was delighted to see them enjoying a well-deserved break from the classroom, challenging themselves in so many ways. A special thanks to our wonderful staff who accompanied the children and who enabled the trip to happen.

Please park with care on drop off and pick up. In recent weeks we have had a pupil injured by the wing mirror of a car parked on the pavement and also, we have had local residents unable to use Giles Lane as access to and from their houses. I know it is a contentious point around all schools, however, please do be thoughtful when parking.

With our daily swimming starting on Tuesday 6th June, please remember to pay the voluntary contribution for this and return the form. Also, remember that entries for the Self Portrait Competition need to be in school on Monday 5th June. They need to be on an A4 piece of paper, in any media, with the child's name and class on the reverse side.

Hopefully many of you have had the opportunity to see the wellie boots on display at Woodbridge Farm shop. The shop will soon be changing the display so, if your child has a boot on display, please collect it from Woodbridge Farm Shop before the end of half term. If you pop in between **Tuesday-Friday 9am-4.00pm**, go to the office when collecting your wellie as they would like to give out a small bottle of flavoured milk for your efforts. They will be removing any remaining boots after half term.

The children will be bringing any remaining Forest School clothing home today. This will not be needed in school for the remainder of the academic year. With the children swimming, lack of time means that any Forest School sessions will be with the children wearing their school uniforms.

Another reminder, with the weather looking a little more favourable, could you please make sure that your child has a sun hat in school and that you apply sun protection prior to school.

If you have any rocks, suitable to build a rockery in our pond, which you could donate to the school, we would very much appreciate it.

Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education (PSHE)

After half term, we will be looking at 'Changes (including Relationships and Sex Education)' in your child's PSHE lessons in school. The lessons on changes focus on different types of changes that can happen in our lives and how to cope with change.
