Dear All,

A very quiet week at All Saints has seen Year 6 pupils starting to volunteer in the village shop, twice a week, as part of their drive to be involved in community projects. Year 6 are also busy ramping up for their practise SATs which will be happening before half term.

Our Year Six 5-a-side football team played in a tournament at the Gryphon School on Thursday. They lost in the final of the Plate and the two matches they lost in the whole tournament both went to penalties (very close).

I am sure that you have heard about the teaching strike that is happening next week. No member of staff has informed me that they intend to strike as yet, there is no obligation to inform me however. If staff members do strike it is my intention, unless it is unsafe, to keep the school open. If there is any change to this, I will inform you at the earliest opportunity.

Elsewhere in the school we are so lucky to have so many wonderful; volunteers who come in to hear the children read: the children love this. Everyone who comes into school comments on the lovely atmosphere and on how polite, calm and well-mannered the children are. To me this is the most special; thing about our school.
