Literal truth Taking words in their most basic sense

Theological truth The creation story contains religious truth about the nature of God

Cosmological Argument An argument for the existence of God saying that God is the first cause.

Teleological Argument an argument for the existence of God based on design in the world



- Is the Genesis 1 creation narrative in conflict or complementary to a scientific account?

Key texts.

From the **book of genesis** in the **Old Testament** of the Bible.



Genesis 1 - In the beginning, God created the heaven and the earth.



Similarities to Other Religions

- Judaism Genesis is also within the Torah.
- Islam The Qu'ran says that the Earth was created in 6 days.

Key knowledge:

Christians believe that God created the universe and God the Creator cares for the **creation**, including human beings.



There is much debate and some controversy around the relationship between the accounts of creation in Genesis and contemporary scientific accounts.

These debates and controversies relate to the purpose and interpretation of the texts. In other words, what genre is **Genesis 1**.

Some Christians believe that the Genesis account of creation is **literally true**. Some Christians see it as a poetic account to inspire worship and awe in God as creator.

There are many scientists, throughout history and now, who are Christians.

The discoveries of science make Christians wonder even more about the power and majesty of the Creator.
