Agreed Rationale:

- At All Saints Primary School we believe that that learning at home is an essential element to the successful development of active learners.
- We feel passionately that children need to understand that learning continues throughout their adult lives. Therefore, it should be promoted everywhere and not only in school.
- We believe that children who are supported and guided at home will feel positive about their learning and this will enhance their progress.
