Dear Parents / Carers,

We are delighted to be able to confirm that we will be repeating our Christmas Hamper Draw this year.

This is how it works:

For example, mince pies, chocolates, jams, nuts, wine etc. The next non-school uniform day is <u>27th</u> <u>November.</u>
- We will then collate as many hampers as possible (last year we had 8)
- Your child will return home with a book of 10 tickets priced at £1 per ticket and it would be great if you could sell them to friends and family if you possibly can.
- Ticket counterfoils, money and unsold tickets to be returned to school by Thursday 10th December.
- All sold tickets will be put into a "Christmas Pot" on <u>Monday 14th December</u> and the lucky winner's names will be drawn, each receiving a fabulous hamper.
- Extra books are available from Mrs Wookey in the office.
- Payment can be returned to the office in a closed envelope along with the counterfoils or there is an option to pay via Sims Agora.
- We will also be offering a child's hamper. All children regardless of if they have sold tickets or not will be entered.

It would be brilliant if we could match last year's success and we understand this is a big request. We would also like to take this opportunity to thank you in advance for your support.
