GUITAR LESSONS

We are very lucky that our wonderful and inspiring guitar teacher, Alister Chester, will be starting lessons again. Group lessons will run every Tuesday from 3:30 – 4:30pm and will offer KS2 children (Ruby & Sapphire Classes) the opportunity to learn the key skills required as a guitarist, as well as how to play some of their favourite songs, all in a relaxed and fun environment.
