In RE we are learning about the story of creation.

The Story

Christians believe that after God created the world, Adam and Eve were but in charge to be stewards of the world. How can we look after the world and be good stewards? Adam and Eve got

greedy and desired equality with God so they took the fruit from the tree. Christians describe this as the first sin. Were Adam and Eve wrong to do this? Did they deserve to be punished?
