First of all, it would be wrong not to mention the passing of the Queen yesterday; she has been a fantastic servant to the country. Our new reception pupils have already settled in wonderfully; it has been lovely to see their enthusiasm and lust for learning. Their settling in has be greatly helped by our superb Year 6 pupils who have been so caring and helpful in their roles as buddies to our new arrivals.

I am delighted to be able to announce that government released data this week which has informed us that All Saints was in the top 5% of schools in the whole country for progress in our KS2 Reading, Writing and Maths SATs. It is a massive achievement to be in the top 5% in one subject, however, to be there in all three subjects has left me speechless (well almost). This is a vindication of our curriculum delivery here at All Saints, but is also testament to the dedication of the staff and attitude of the pupils throughout the school.

Ruby Class are looking forward to their first ukulele lesson on Wednesday and will be taking their instruments home to practice. These instruments need to be back in school each Tuesday.

For your information, Sarah Barnes led a PSHE based assembly on Wednesday where she discussed why we call 999 (ambulance, police, fire service and coast guard) and the importance of only calling for an emergency. The school listened to two recordings of children ringing 999 and the conversations they had with the operator until the paramedics came.

As a reminder, every child should have their PE kit (including trainers) and Forest school kit (including boots) in school.
