We are delighted to be able to confirm the programme of events that we have organised for our Book week which starts on Monday 12th March. It is going to be an exciting and rewarding week for all! Please encourage your children to become as involved as possible!

Monday 12th March

We are very excited that the Book Week at All Saints will launch with a visit by the author Paul Stickland who wrote 'Dinosaur Roar'. He will begin the day by taking a whole class assembly introducing his work. Then every child will participate in a workshop with him during the day when they will be taking part in hands on activities making pop up books. A flyer will be distributed from Paul as copies of his books will be available to buy on the day he will also be happy to sign old battered copies on the day!

Tuesday 13th March

We are again being visited by an author, this time by Rocky Salt the author of 'An Animalphabet'. He will be discussing how he writes his books with KS1 and KS2 children. Rocky can sell and sign his books on the day for £8 but would need a rough number needed before the visit. Please let your child's teacher know if you would like to buy the book on the day.
