Dear All,

I hope you had a fantastic summer: we are all excited to be back and starting the new academic year and I would like to take this opportunity of welcoming our new reception families. Also, a very warm welcome to Emma Skea-Strachan who has taken over the reigns of Topaz Class.

I am amazed at how quickly our children have settled back into school life: if they are anything like me they will have been exhausted, however, school has been the lovely environmental we are all used to. I am also delighted to say that our new school meals are 'going down a storm'. Meals need to be ordered 1 week in advance. If you have any trouble booking meals or clubs, please speak to Kirsty in the office. Monday food order: you may notice Monday's selection has disappeared, if you know you have ordered food for your child for Monday it will still stand as Kirsty puts the orders in the week before.

For non-reception pupils, if photo permission has changed, if you child has changes to dietary needs and if there are any changes to your child's allergies, please call Kirsty in the office ASAP.

We are looking forward to seeing parents/carers of pupils from Year 1 – Year 6 for a 'meet the teacher' session at 3pm next Tuesday (12th September). If you are unable to attend, or have more than one child at school, slideshows used will be made available on the class pages on our website after the event. A few pleas. Could you please ensure that all of your child's children's uniform and PE kit are named. Collectively, staff spend hours every week trying to locate unnamed items. Next, could you please ensure that your child has a full PE kit (including trainers not daps) and a warm hoodie / sweatshirt in school. This will generally be kept in school for the full half term, though we will send it homes if it becomes smelly! Also, could we please make sure your child has named waterproofs and wellington boots which can be used for forest school activities. Failure to have the correct clothing could mean that your child misses out on activities. As ever, if you are struggling to source any of the items, please contact Kirsty as we may be able to help.

Your Child May Be Entitled to Additional Funds

If you receive:

- Income Support.
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance.
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance.
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
- The Guarantee element of State Pension Credit

You will probability be entitled to additional support for your child (this includes free school meals throughout their schooling and money to spend on equipment, uniform, trips, clubs If you believe that you may fall in to this category,)

To apply for this, either:

- Apply on line https://www.dorsetcouncil.gov.uk/-/pupil-premium. You will then immediately find out if you are eligible for this additional funding
