Dear All,

Many thanks for everyone who supported The Wurzels concert on Saturday: it was a resounding success. I would like to pass on my personal thanks to Vicky and the ASSA team who were so dedicated in making this event happen. I have seen how much hard work and how many hours the team put in to make this event so successful: they have been incredible. At time of writing, and before we have received our share of the bar takings, ASSA have raised over £2500 from this one event. All this money goes directly to enriching the All Saints experience for all pupils.
