Dear All,

I apologise for the disruption to swimming this week. Unfortunately, the rain has dropped the pool temperature quite considerably and the weather has not helped the heaters in warming the water up sufficiently. My guidelines state that the pool has to be 28°C for children to swim and earlier in the week we were down to 24°C! Please rest assured, if we can swim, we will.

Having relooked at what we are allowed to do and listened to the views of staff and parents, I have decided that parents of our Year 6 Leavers will be able to watch their children in the KS2 Performance which will be taking place at 2pm on Thursday 15th July.
