One of our main concerns over the post 'lockdown 1' period has been the mental health and well-being of our pupils. We have spent a lot of teaching time discussing the worries and concerns of pupils, answering questions and trying to put a bit of perspective on what is happening. Pupils are regularly reminded on what to do if they have any worries and each class has a worry box where pupils can write down their worries either anonymously or named; these are all followed up on. If your child(ren) has any worries or concerns you would like us to address, please do get in touch.

We had a lovely Remembrance Service on Wednesday. With each group in their bubbles, we explained the significance of the day, why it is important we remember the sacrifices that were made by millions. We reflected that whilst times may be difficult now, things have been a lot worse in the past. Pupils were given the opportunity to discuss their thoughts and concerns in their bubbles after the service.
